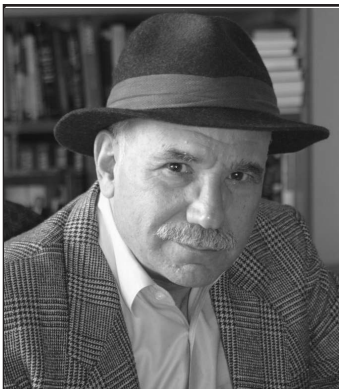


Middle East and Arab Spring 10 Years After the Invasion of Iraq

Iraq: What the News Media Didn't Tell You, co-authored with Norman Solomon, became a best seller in 2003. *The Iran Agenda: The Real Story of US Policy and the Middle East Crisis* was published in 2007. *Dateline Havana: The Real Story of US Policy and the Future of Cuba* was published in 2009. *Conversations with Terrorists: Middle East Leaders on Politics, Violence and Empire*, was published in 2010.
