September 23 marks one year since the US began bombing Syria under the guise of fighting the Islamic State/ISIS. The US continues to assert that one of their goals is regime change in Syria, training and arming "moderate" rebels, while at the same time tacitly supporting Al Qaeda offshoot the Nusra Front since they too are fighting ISIS. Meanwhile, the US has now gained full cooperation from Turkey, which is using the chaos as an excuse to bomb Kurdish nationalists in Iraq and Syria, even though those Kurdish fighters have proven the most effective at keeping ISIS from holding territory.
