- The immediate withdrawal of all U.S. military forces from the Persian Gulf.
- U.S. support for a peaceful negotiated solution to the Iraq-Kuwait crisis.
- No permanent U.S. military bases in the Middle East.
- The use of federal tax dollars for the development of non-nuclear alternatives to oil, and for other human needs, not for war.
